DECISION

Deloitte Consulting, LLP, of Arlington, Virginia, protests the award of a contract to ESCgov, Inc., of McLean, Virginia, by the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) under solicitation No. HC1028-12-R-0025.

We dismiss the protest.

The jurisdiction of our Office is established by the bid protest provisions of the Competition in Contracting Act of 1984, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3551-3556 (2006). Our role in resolving bid protests is to ensure that the statutory requirements for full and open competition are met. Pacific Photocopy and Research Servs., B-278698, B-278698.3, Mar. 4, 1998, 98-1 CPD ¶ 69 at 4.

Subsequent to the filing of these protests, DISA granted the relief requested, which rendered the protests academic. Specifically, the agency states that it will take the following corrective action:

1. Terminate for Convenience the award to ESCgov because it is not a current BMC authorized partner and does not have the right to resell BMC products. (See Exhibit A-BMC letter dated 2 August 2012 filed as part of record by Protestor's counsel on 6 August 2012).
2. Award to Deloitte Consulting LLP which is the next vendor in line for this source selection.

Agency Notice of Corrective Action (Aug. 16, 2012), at 2. We do not consider
